That I C. A. Key at present of Tinnandmas
County of Nassau and State of Florida, lately
resident at Jonesboro County of Clayton State
of Georgia Teacher, being in ill health but of
sound and disposing mind, and memory, do
make and publish this my last will & testament
hereby revoking all former wills, by me at any
time heretofore made.

My will is that, after the payment of my
funeral expenses, I give devise and bequeath
freely, voluntarily without reservation and with-
out any solicitation to my beloved sister Mrs.
Ella O. Morrow of Jonesboro Georgia all personal
property and accounts and realty of which I
shall hereafter acquire and possess or to which I
may be entitled at the time of my decease.
Also to my said beloved sister I foreward do
devise and bequeath the full proceeds of my
Endowment Policy for Two thousand dollars
as a member of Clayton Lodge number 187,
Knights of Honor of Jonesboro Georgia.

These I bequeath to her in consideration of
her kindness in caring for my little son known
as Little Gus Key now deceased, and for the
affection I bear for her.

law J. W. Evans executor of this my last Will and
Testament this December 30th 1884.
