I, David L. Duffey of the County and State aforesaid, being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart this life, deem it right and proper as concerns myself and family that I should make a disposition of the property which a kind providence has blessed me. I therefore make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st I desire and direct that all of my just debts be paid out of the estate hereafter set apart for that purpose.

Item 2nd I desire and direct that my body be decently buried and that a suitable tombstone be placed at my grave furnished from the effects of my estate.

I have with me my beloved wife M. E. Duffey my gold watch also to her and her present children by me the house and part of Lots of land No 53 and the where I now live together with the wagons and baggage and tools and all appurtenances belonging thereto separate and distinct from the factory then and all appurtenances to them and you and family before being thirty acres more or less belonging to the said lot. Also all the stock in my debt or horse or mule if there should be more than two to be sold and applied to my debt.

Item 3rd I hereby direct that my factory, gear and land belonging and all that pertains to them and twelve acres of land known as the Daniel bottom part of Lot 109 be sold at public and or privately if thought best and applied to the payment of my debts after my notes, account and one of my horse stock have been used up for that purpose and the balance to be equally divided between my three first children W. W. Duffey M. E. Duffey and H. J. Williams. If the debts can be satisfactorily arranged and the legates wish to hold the above named property without selling they can do so.

Item 4th I constitute J. R. Daniel of Clayton County my executor to act for me and in my name to execute this my last will and testament and hereby revoke and annul all other wills made heretofore by me. I, D. L. Duffey do this my will here set my hand and seal. This Dec 7th 1878. D. L. Duffey S. S.

I hereby constitute and appoint my friend P. J. Bond
 and Jackson Highgate Executors of this my last Will and testament
 this 14th June 1886
