Clayton County Wills 1850-1892
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I David James of Clayton County in the name of God Amen
do hereby make this my last will and testament in full of my mind and
right of proper both as respects myself and my property that I have
made in disposition of the property with which I have been
blessed by the favor of God the Father and the Holy Spirit
hereby bequeathing all of mine hereof to my dear wife Mary

- 1st I desire my body buried in a Christian like manner.
- 2nd I desire all my just debts be paid without delay by
my executor hereafter appointed.
- 3rd I give bequeath to Mary D Lee one hundred & fifty two
(152) acres of land in Clayton County lot number six hundred
& fifty two (152) in the eleventh (11th) District Being the land I
bought of Mrs Willingham
- 4th I give bequeath to Lelia Alice Allen right right (88) acres
of land in Fayette County being a part of a lot number
(216) two hundred & sixteen known as the land I bought of J D
Stalock also four acres in Clayton County being
in the one thousand eight eighth (1888) District Being the land I
bought of Mary C Adams adjoining her other lands
- 5th I give bequeath to Elizabeth McWilliams one hundred acres of
land in Clayton County being sweet half of a lot being lot number
eighty nine (89) at her death this land is to go to her son James M
Blom. If he should die before her then it is to go to her
daughter Lellie M Williams
- 6th I give bequeath to my daughter Julia J James one thousand
dollars in cash I direct my executor to invest this in land
either in Georgia or Texas and the deed made to her & the heirs
of her body after using some of it for boarding & educating her
- 7th I give bequeath this money & property to Mary D Lee Lelia
Alice Allen & Julia J James my three youngest children
to them & their children the heirs of their body only
- 8th The entire balance of my estate I wish divided equally
among my ten children or their heirs if dead I wish that
James should go equally to assign children
- 9th Now should either of my children or any friend of theirs
commence a suit for the purpose of breaking this last will
Child or Children is to have no interest or share of my estate
in any manner
- 10th I appoint my son John H James of Atlanta my executor
with power to him to sign & convey in title or he think his best according
to the will with power to sell the property at public or
private sale. In case of his death I appoint James H Blom
to be my executor
