of my worldly effects, I will and do give
my share which to that who you are, and that my
body be buried in the graveyard with my first
wife, and its seven sisters the place all owing
gravel like hers.
- Item 2nd I will and bequeath for the natural love and af-
fection I have for my wife Elizabeth Crawley
the West end Bedstead also and the Kitchen fur-
niture, also three hundred pounds of Pork also
twenty five Bushels of Corn and one white
Cow and calf.
- Item 3rd I will and bequeath for the natural love and af-
fection I have for Francis B. Crawley my son
fifty acres of land in being in the North West corner
of Lot No (176) in Spaulding County it being
situated at two hundred and thirty one and one
half miles.
- Item 4th I will and bequeath for the natural love and af-
fection that I have for my daughter Fessie J. F.
Sticks fifty acres more or less of ground it being
in the South West corner of Lot No 176 in Spaulding
County Ga. it being situated at three hundred and
eighty dollars and Fessie J. Sticks to have it in
said land.
- Item 5th I will and bequeath for the natural love and af-
fection I have for my son Sanders A. B. Crawley twenty
acres of ground more or less it being all
West of Flint River on lot No (176) in Fayette
County Ga. to him his life time then to his heirs
it being valued at four hundred and dollars.
- Item 6th I will and bequeath for the natural love and af-
fection that I have for my daughter Fessie J. F.
Sticks fifty acres of land more or less it
being on the East side of Flint River more or less
Lot No (176) to her her life time then to the heirs of
her body after her death it being valued at one
hundred and fifty dollars in a year the four.

Crawley thirty acres of land more or less it
being on the East side of Flint River of Lot No
(176) in Spaulding County Ga. to her her life time
and then to the heirs of her body or her heirs
it being valued at two hundred and dollars.

fection that I have for my daughter Novella A. B.
Crawley thirty acres of land more or less it
being on the East side of Flint River of Lot No
(176) in Spaulding County Ga. to her her life time
and then to the heirs of her body or her heirs
it being valued at two hundred and dollars.

be not mentioned in the foregoing letters be sold at public sale
after my death and the proceeds of the sale be divided among
all my children and my wife and all of my children counting all the afore-
said mentioned movements after my death of my first-
born at the time of my death with my second-born

body of my daughter Elizabeth James Hatcher be and their
heirs forever heirs of my estate also I direct that my
grand daughter Elizabeth Hatcher be and she be by
appointed her trustee for her mother's portion & for the

Item 11 I, Matthew Crawley declare under penalties in
the presence of the undersigned witnesses that the
matter contained in the foregoing letters to be my
