Item 1st I desire & Direct that my Body be buried in a decent &
Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances and
Conditions in life. My Soul I trust shall return to
rest with the god who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation
through the merits and atonement of the Blessed Lord &
Savior Jesus Christ whose Religion I have professed and
I humbly trust enjoyed for twenty nine years

Item 2nd I desire & Direct that all my just debts be paid without delay
by my Executors hereafter appointed as I am unwilling my
Creditors should be delayed in their rights especially as there
is no necessity for delay

Item 3rd I give & bequeath to & devise to my beloved wife Sarah with
Whom I have lived in the strictest unity for forty years a Lot of
Land No (78) Seventy Eight in the 12th District of Henry
County containing two hundred two and one half acres about eighty
acres cleared & in cultivation to have & to hold as long as
she lives or during her widowhood I also give and bequeath
to my beloved wife in the same manner the farming utensils
wood on said plantation & also two young mares my cattle & hogs
household & Kitchen furniture belonging to and used on said
plantation the perishable property to sell & dispose of
for the use of the family as she sees proper

Item 4th I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Jane Alvey
Nolan fifty acres of Land in the 12th District of Henry
County No 78 not recollecting lying on the East side and
of the Lot where Thos A Nolan now lives with all the
rights priviledges & priviliges to said fifty acres of Land
in any wise appertaining or belonging forever. I also
give my daughter Jane the young horse & horse I have now
one Cow & calf she has of her own picking one young
sow & pigs her bed & furniture chest & the contents to
dispose of as she thinks best

Item 5th I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Nolan two hundred
acres of Land in the 12th District of Henry County No 78
viz for the Lot of Land No (78) in the 12th District of Henry
County to be equally divided between Martha my daughter
& her son Thos A Nolan and also her bed & furniture chest
and contents

Item 6th The rest of my property both real & personal whether now
or whatever it may be including that given to my
wife Sarah during her natural life or widowhood
with the exception of half the Lot of Land before mentioned
to my daughter Martha I give & bequeath & devise to my dear
son R M Nolan forever to have & to hold to him & his heirs
friends Thos A Nolan the husband of the person &
property of my said minor son R M Nolan
