that I most shortly depart this life, deem it right and pro-
per both as respect my family and myself that I should
make a disposition of the property which a kind Pro-
vience has blessed me. I do therefore make this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling
all others by me heretofore made,
1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent
and christlike manner suitable to my circumstances
and condition in life. My soul shall return to rest with
God who gave it as I hope for salvation through the merits
and atonement of the blessed Lord and savior Jesus Christ.
2nd I desire and direct that all of my just debts of every kind
by my executor hereinafter named and appointed,
3rd I give and bequeath and devise to my beloved son in law
J. W. Evans all my notes and claims, I have and hold on the south
half of Lot of Land number six hundred and fifty two 1/2
in the 13th district of originally Fayette now Clayton County and
against the lands of J. W. Evans said land having
heretofore been deeded by me to said J. W. Evans for a
valuable consideration.
4th I hereby constitute and appoint my friend and son in
law J. W. Evans executor of this my last Will and
Testament. This December 30th 1884.
