 portion of said will do make this Codicil.
 That the boundary of the ten acres of land bequeathed Robert L & James
 L.P. Adamson be changed as follows commencing at the South West
 of N.C. Adamson's land on middle of South line of Lot No 188 running
 North half across said lot and West far enough to make ten acres
 That the remainder of the South West quarter of said lot mentioned
 in Deeds 475th & given and bequeath to Wm F. Adamson (except that
 portion described in deeds heretofore made to the Rock Baptist Church)
 The same to be held in trust by him during his lifetime for his
 children he having the use of said land during life and in case
 of the death of said W.F. Adamson and his children should die without
 living issue said lands to pass to the other heirs of my estate.
 All portions of Deeds 475th in conflict with the foregoing I hereby revoke
 and annul
 I give to F.P. Adamson the right to a road or right of way whose
 the road now runs from his line to the Gravel road through
 that portion described in bequest to Sarah & James in Deed 7th
 Signed May 28th 1895
