

Will of Rachel Abernethy

State of Georgia, in Clayton County Wills, 1859-1921
Henry County
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I Rachel Abernethy of said State and County, being of sound mind and memory, and knowing that life is uncertain, deem it right and proper that I should make a disposition of the little property with which kind Providence has blessed me. I do therefore make this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made.

First, I desire and direct that my body be buried in a Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances in life. - I commit my soul to God who gave it, as I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Secondly - I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my executor hereinafter appointed.

Thirdly - I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved Sister Mary Bradberry, all my property, goods, and chattels of every kind, including household and kitchen furniture, stock, money, notes or any other property of whatever kind I may possess at my decease, either in my possession or in the possession of any one else.

Fourthly - I hereby appoint and constitute my friend and sister Mary Bradberry Executor of this my last will and Testament.

In witness whereof, I hereby set my hand and affix my seal, this 19th day of May 1854.
