

Will of Mrs Sarah A. Oslin - Made 15th April 1885

Clayton County Wills 1859-1921

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State of Georgia } In the name of God, Amen
Clayton County }

I, Sarah A. Oslin being of advanced age, but of sound and disposing mind, and memory, knowing that I must shortly depart this life, deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself, that I should make a disposition of the property which a kind Providence has blessed me with.

I do therefore make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and annulling all others by me heretofore made.

1st I desire and direct my body to be buried in a decent and Christian manner, according to my circumstances in life; my soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it.

2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter appointed and named.

3rd I give, bequeath and devise to my beloved daughter Lela Oslin all my property, both real and personal, viz: The real estate consisting of the South half of Lot No. 1 in the original 5th District of Henry now Clayton County, Georgia, containing one hundred acres, more or less, bounded South by W. S. P. Chambers, West by A. J. Moody, North by R. S. Moody, and being the place where our family live; ~~except twenty four acres off of East side of said half lot.~~ Personal property consisting of household and kitchen furniture together with cows and all other personal property that I may be possessed of at the time of my death.

4th I desire and direct that the said Lela Oslin shall furnish to my beloved daughter Mrs Anna Malone & her children, while in childhood a home on the premises as long as she the said Anna may wish to stay.

5th I desire and direct that the said Lela Oslin have the right to sell or in any way dispose of said property in any way she may think best.

6th Should the said Lela Oslin die without child or children, I give bequeath and devise to my beloved daughter Mrs Anna Malone (and heirs) the aforesaid mentioned property whenever it may be.

7th I constitute and appoint my Executor to this my last and testament.

This 15th day of April 1885.
