and ten dollars the others shall receive an equal amount - he
shall share an equal with my other children I do hereby appoint John
W. Dickey and William A. Dickey executors of this my last will
and Testament in witness whereof I the said William W. Dickey
to this my will consisting of the foregoing two sheets of paper have
set my hand and seal this the first day of February 1878
