I, Irwin R. Booth

mind and memory,
knowing that I must
shortly depart this life,
deem it right and proper
both as respects my
family and myself,
that I should make
a disposition of the property
with which a kind Providence
has blessed me, I do
therefore make this my
last will and testament
hereby revoking and
annulling all others
if any by me heretofore
made.

First:

I desire, and direct
that my body be buried
in a decent and Christian
like manner suitable
to my circumstances in
life. My soul I trust shall
return to rest with God
who gave it, and hope for
salvation through the
merits and atonement
of the Blessed Lord
and Savior Jesus
Christ.

Secondly,

I desire and direct that all my just debts, if any, be paid as soon as practicable out of my estate by my Executor hereinafter named and appointed.

Thirdly,

I hereby appoint my beloved wife Margaret L. Booth, Guardian of the person and property of all my minor children, and I give, bequeath and devise to her all my estate both real and personal, wherever and whatever it may be, with full power and authority to manage and control the same during her lifetime as may be for the best interest of the estate, and to lease, take use and enjoy the same or such part or portion thereof as may be necessary for her comfort and support during life and for the maintenance and education of my minor children. This bequest and the provision herein made for my wife

in lieu of dower, and
my and all other interest
whenever they might become
in and to my estate.

And after the death
of my beloved wife, I
give, bequeath and devise
all the residue of my
estate, which may then
be left to my beloved
children, Thomas R. Booth,
Louella D. Booth, Leonard C.
Booth, Moody Booth, Louisa
Booth, Sarah D. Booth and
Addie H. Booth, share
and share alike forever
in fee simple in case
of the death of any
of my said child with
issue then the child
or children left by them
to inherit and possess
their share in their stead,
but should any of my
said children die without
issue then those surviving
them and being in life at
the death of my beloved
wife, to inherit the en-
tire residue of my estate.

I hereby

constitute and
appoint my son
John E. Booth Executor
of my last will
and testament, and enjoin
upon him and my
deaths, after paying
my just debts

as hereinafter provided
 to aid my beloved wife
 in the execution of the
 duties and trust therein
 imposed in her, and
 at her death to see
 to it that the residue
 of my estate
 be justly and equitably
 divided in manner
 as hereinbefore provided,
 and that all my
 wishes and desires
 as herein expressed
 be fully carried out.
