 Collins for and in consideration of the natural love and affection
 which he has and bears to his said nephews James D. and Dovie
 Collins, hath given granted and conveyed unto the said James D.
 and Dovie Collins, their heirs and assigns, reserving to himself the said
 Peter Collins, a life estate therein an undivided half interest
 in all that tract or parcels of land situate, lying and being
 in the Twentieth (20th) district and Second (2^d) Section
 said County, known and described in the plan of said
 tract as lots of land known as Two Hundred and Twenty
 (222) and Two Hundred and Twenty (222) containing
 Three Hundred and Twenty (320) acres more or less.

 heirs and assigns, together with all the rights, benefits and
 appurtenances to said Tract of land in any manner whatsoever
