my money property and effects
that may be my estate after
the foregoing bequests shall have
been paid to be equal to divided
among all of my child and
son H. Smith Abraham W. Smith
James S. Smith Mary M. S. Smith
Rebecca James Smith Sallie Smith
and John Reed.

Sixth.

I desire the foregoing bequests
to be paid as named in their respec-
tive actions or laws.
