Recorded December 7th 1867. Prob. Court Ordinary
Dotson. B. Wright's Will.

State of Georgia In the name of God A. Amen.
Cobb County I, J. Dotson B. Wright, of said State and County, being of
sound and disposing Mind and Memory, knowing that I must shortly
depart this life, deem it right and proper, both as it respects my Family
and myself, that I should make a disposition of the property with which
a kind Providence has blessed me with, I do therefore make this my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking and annulling all others, by me
heretofore made.

First, I desire and direct that all my just debt, be paid by my Executors
herein after named and appointed.

Secondly. I give and bequeath and devise to my beloved Wife Henrietta Wright
all of my property, both real and personal viz Three Lots of Land
and two fractions of of Lot Number, 274. 275. 291. 292. 335, all in the
First District and Second section of Cobb County, and two Negroes, (viz) Sarah,
a boy and a girl Beniah.

Thirdly I desire and direct that if the above named Negroes should become
uncontrollable by my Wife she may dispose or make sale of

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them, and use the proceeds thereof to the best advantage for the support of my family.

Fourthly - I further direct, that if my wife can sell the above named Lots, of Land, and buy more Land that she thinks will be more advantage for the support of her and family, it is my desire that it be done.

Fifthly - I further direct, that my wife shall dispose of any of my property, or so much thereof, as shall be necessary for the payment, of my debts, or the support of my family, as she may think best.

Sixthly - I further direct, that if my wife Henrietta Wright, should marry again, that all of my property both real and personal be sold and equally divided between my wife, and my children viz Thomas, Es. Charles Es. Augustus E. William A. Alva D. Edwin Robert H. & Charles the 11th Wright, and if my wife should die without marrying a gain, I desire that my property all be sold and divided between my above named children.

Seventhly - I further direct, that my wife shall carry on the Name to the best advantage she can, and make and dispose of any of the proceeds thereof, for the use and support of my family and education of the children.

Eighthly - I further direct, that as my children become, of age that my Executors shall give them a Horse, Cudde and Saddle, or One Hundred and fifty Dollars, in Money, or either of them as may be most convenient for them to do.

Ninthly - I do hereby constitute and appoint my Wife Henrietta Wright, and my brother Edwin E. Wright, Executors and Administrators of my last Will and Testament,

Witness my hand and seal this 20th December 1862.

Robert B Wright as his last Will and Testament

his special instance and request, and in the
presence of each other.
