

Will of Mrs Dorothy Stephens

and State, being of sound mind and memory, do make and declare this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills.

Item I
I should I owe any debts at the time of my death, I desire that my executors pay them as soon thereafter as possible.

Item II
I give, bequeath and devise unto my children John T., Wm P., J. E., Effie, Charley and Ima, and my two grand children Beltha and Ed. Evans, my entire estate of every kind and class to have and enjoy forever in fee simple. Each of my said children shall have an undivided one seventh interest in my estate, and the other seventh interest shall be divided equally between my said grand children above named. In the event of the death of any one or more of my children prior to my death, leaving a child or children, the interest of such child shall go to and vest in his or her child or children in the same way it would have gone to him or her, had he or she remained in life; but in the event of any one or more of my children prior to my own death, such child or child or children leaving no child or children, then the interest of such deceased child or children shall go to the other legatees of this will in the same manner as herein provided. In the event of the death of either of said grand children then the share of such deceased grandchild shall go to the surviving grandchild.

Item III
I hereby appoint my three sons, Wm P., John T. and J. E. my executors to carry out my wishes as expressed in this will. I authorize and empower my executors, or each of them as may act, to sell and dispose of my estate, real and personal with out any order of any court, at either public or private sale, at such time and in such way, for cash or credit, as my executors or a majority of them, may deem best, until sell they are authorized and directed to manage and control my properties, collect the rents and apply the same under the provisions
