Eubanks, I give bequeath and devise to my wife Phoebe Eubanks the following acres of land consisting of land lots numbers (713) four hundred and thirteen, (414) four hundred and fourteen, and (7) nine acres off (380) three hundred and fifteen and (30) thirty acres Two miles, two miles horse and harness, one buggy and wagon and my plantation tools, all of my household and kitchen furniture for her own proper use benefit and behoof during her natural life.

Item, 2nd

I want my Daughters Cora and Ella Eubanks to have a support from the farm as long as they remain single.

Item, 3rd

After the death of my wife and my Daughters Cora and Ella Eubanks marry and leave the place, I want the notes held by J. T. Eubanks, J. B. Eubanks and J. J. Eubanks paid and after the afore mentioned notes are paid I want the ballance of my property equally divided among my heirs.

Item, 4th

I hereby constitute and appoint my two Sons J. T. Eubanks and J. B. Eubanks Executors of this my last will and testament.
