Goulding of the Town of Roswell County of Cobb & State of Georgia bearing sound mind at the time of making and publishing this my last will and testament I give and devise all my Estate real and personal whereof I may be seized or possessed to my beloved brother Henry R. Reese of the County of Polk and State of Georgia and Henry G. Reese of Fulton County Georgia. To have and to hold the same to themselves their heirs and assigns forever upon the uses and trusts following. Viz in trusts to pay all my debts and funeral expenses. Secondly to hold the same in trust for the use and benefit of my two daughters Matilda R. Goulding and Emma R. Goulding and it is my desire that so long as they remain single that the property should be held together for their mutual benefit. But should they marry to be equally divided and should either or both of them die leaving issue then the property to be divided among their children share and share alike; and should they die without issue then the to go to the nearest of kin on the maternal side. And I hereby give to my said Trustees full power and authority without order of Court to sell any or all of my real Estate at public or private sale and if necessary use the same for the support of my said daughters or to invest the proceeds or to lease the same as they may deem best for their interest.

And I hereby nominate and appoint my said Trustees executors of this my last will and testament.

Item 1st

I hereby nominate and appoint

Georgia and also my friend
C. M. Webb of the County of

having my hand to the my last will
and testament said Executors to serve
without involving returns to my last
will to be served by me as directed

Item 2nd

It is further my wish that so far
as is practicable my said Executors
keep the property I have and at the
death of both my daughter my said
Executors or their successors shall
among the said property to some char-
itable institution as in their judgment
should serve best

Item 3rd

I give to my said Executors full
power and authority without any
other power any South Chatham
within my death to sell any or all of
my Estate Real or personal at public
or private sale if in their judgment
they should think best and
if necessary use the proceeds from
said sale for the support of my
widow and her good & pay all just
debts due either by them or contracted
by myself or to be used in the purchase
of a homestead property as they may deem
best

Item 4th

I give to my said Executors full
authority to clear out and fully wind
up the affairs of my Estate as far
as directed and as directed in
and with where as well as with
compliance with this Codex of either
of said Executors should die or be
removed without the consent of said
State then I give the other Executor
full authority to act and carry out
the provisions of my will and
Codex and also full authority
to appoint, amend and terminate
power to fill the measure

That if the Executors do remove
should still desire to act as Ex-
ecutors then it is my wish that
Continue to do
