

Will of E. W. Medlock
 Dated in Johnson County October Term 1864

Georgia Cobb County
 I, E. W. Medlock of said County, being of sound
 and dispoised mind and Memory, do make this my last will
 and testament.

Item 1. I give to my beloved wife Julia Anne Medlock five hundred
 dollars in money which I desire shall be paid to her
 out of my estate by my Executors and Executor, herein after named.

Item 2. I give to my son Oscar Dodge Medlock, two hundred and
 fifty dollars, which I desire shall be paid to
 him out of my estate by my Executors and Executor, herein named
 in the will.

Item 3. I give to Pearl Medlock, Ralph Medlock, Wren Medlock,
 and Emie Medlock the children of my deceased son John
 Bryant Medlock, five hundred dollars, to be equally divi-
 ded between them, which I desire to be paid to them
 out of my estate by Executors and Executor, herein named.

Item 4. I give to my sisters Long Ethel Medlock, Mary Medlock,
 Sophia Thomas Medlock, George Medlock, Julia Don Medlock
 the children of my deceased son Thomas C. Medlock five
 hundred dollars, to be equally divided, ^{between them} which I desire
 I desire shall be paid to them out of my estate by my
 Executors and Executor, herein named.

Item 5. The remainder of my property, that is all the property both
 real and personal, whatever and wherever it may be, that I
 may have at the time of my death, other than that disposed
 of, herein given by the foregoing clauses of this will, I give to
 my children William Heyman Medlock, Charley Woodson
 Medlock, Ellis Brown Medlock, Mrs. Lora Dandridge,
 Mrs. Anne Don Godfrey, Thad. Nicholson Medlock, and
 James Harwell Medlock, to be equally divided, ^{between} them share
 and share alike. I appoint my wife Julia Anne
 Medlock and my son James Harwell Medlock Executors and
 Executor respectively of this my last will and testament this August
 the 30th 1864.
