 I, Sarah Slughter, being of sound mind and disposing memory, being of such perfect use of life and understanding, do hereby declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
 I give and bequeath to my husband, John H. Slughter all my property, both real and personal, to my dear and darling, my husband, and I do not to her children.
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my husband, John H. Slughter, executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills made by me at any time.

Signed, sealed, published and declared as the last Will and Testament of Sarah Slughter in our presence. Said Will signed in our presence and witnessed by us at her request, and signed by each of us in her presence and in the presence of each other. This November the 28th 1889.
