Last Will of Alfred Terry

I, Alfred Terry of said State and County being
of sound and disposing mind and memory
testament thereby revoking all wills heretofore
made by me.

I wish my executors as soon as possible
after my death to pay my debts if a sale of
property shall be necessary I wish them to
select for sale that which can be most advantage-
ously used for that purpose and I authorize
them to sell the same at public or private
sale as they may see fit.

I give to my beloved wife Lucinda and
children that remain at home and unmarried
full contrall of all my property and effects to
live off of and school the minor children.

I give to Mary Terry provided she was to
marry and leave the same as I gave the rest
when they married and the Organ extras.
I give to my two sons Willie and Thomas the
rest as they become of age the same as the rest,
except a cow I give them a horse bridal and
saddle in lieu of cow.

I then after the death of my wife and the
children have all married that what property
is left to be equally divided between my
bodily heirs.

I do hereby appoint Thomas G. Terry and
Lucinda and my son William H. Terry
executors of this my will and testament
in testimony whereof I have set my hand
and affix my seal.
