Knowing that I must shortly depart this life I declare it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make and dispose of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me. I do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all others by me heretofore made of any.

I then 1st

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my circumstances and conditions in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God. Who gave it and I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

I then 2nd

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my Executor hereinafter named.

I then 3rd

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Emily Smith for and during her natural life 2 lots of land numbered Eight hundred and sixty four in the Seventeenth district and Second Section of Said County. with all other property both real and personal wherever and whatever it may be and that at her death, I desire and direct and bequeath the same to my afflicted daughter Minerva Smith in fee simple and forever.

And I have heretofore given to my Son E. S. Smith. One Black mule valued at \$200. One milch Cow valued at \$200 and lot of Land No. 866 in the 17th district and 3rd Section of Said County valued at \$200. And it is my will that this be in full Settlement to him for his interest in my estate and as I have heretofore given to my Son Chesley Smith (now deceased) One mare valued at \$1200. One milch Cow valued at \$200 and lot of Land No. 868 in the 17th district and 3rd Section of Said County valued at \$200. it is my will that this be in full Settlement to him and to my daughter Emily Smith now Emily Brown wife.
