a support for my wife and keep my property
in good condition that said executor
hereafter named keep the income from
the surplus charge for division at
the death of my wife or to such my

death of her death of the same children
that named shall take an equal share
entire share in the remainder of my
estate. It is my desire that my property
be divided in kind between those named
children without any sales either through
themselves or through the intervention of
disinterested persons except for them
but should it become impracticable
to divide my personal property then
my executor be authorized to advertise
such personal property as such sales are
usually advertised and sell such per-
sonal property and divide the proceeds thereof
equally between children named in
this will. It is my desire that should
any of my named children die before the
division of said property among them who
shall leave a child or children that
such child or children shall stand
in the place of its or their deceased
parent and take the share that would
have gone to the parent. Should any
one of the named children named in
this will die before the division of
said property and leaving no child or
children then the share of such child
shall be equally divided between
the other survivors of said named child
