In the name of God - Amen

I, Valentine Kolb, of the county and State aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind, and memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament - and do hereby revoke all other Wills heretofore made.

Item 1. - I will and direct - that my body be decently buried.

Item 2. - I will and direct - that all my just debts be paid.

Item 3. - It is my will and desire that all my property, be kept together, until my youngest child becomes of age, but - that my Executrix hereinafter named may make any advancements to any of my said children, as a loan, as she may think proper, not to exceed their proportionate part of my said estate.

Item 4. - I will and direct - that the Guardian of my children hereinafter named, shall have all of my said chil-

Item 2. - I will and direct that all my just and rightful heirs and devisees shall have my present and future estate that my body be decently buried and disposed of. To my wife and my children I give and bequeath my present and future estate.

Item 3. - It is my will and desire that all my just and rightful heirs and devisees shall have my present and future estate that my youngest child becomes of age, but that my Executrix hereinafter named may make property due advancements to any of my said children, as a loan, as she may think proper, not to exceed their proportionate part of my said estate.

Item 4. - I will and direct that the Guardian of my three children hereinafter named, shall have all of my said estate, to my three children well educated and supported even to any encroachment upon the corpus of said estate.

Item 5. - I will and direct that my said Executrix, whose name is Julian, have full and undivided right and power to dispose of my property, either real or personal, by sale, either public or private, as she may see proper, and vest the proceeds of such a sale as she may think best, or to use the same in the education and maintenance of my said children.

Item 6. - I hereby appoint my beloved wife, Eliza T. ^{Esq.}, my Executrix, to carry out this my last Will and Testament in the manner and I do further appoint my said wife the Guardian of my said children during their minority, with all the powers above specified.

Item 7. - It is my will and desire that at the time when my youngest child becomes of age, all of my said property then remaining after the education and maintenance of said children, The

be equally divided among my said children and my beloved wife, share and share alike.
