

Valentine Kolb's Will.

Georgia
Cobb County

In the name of God - Amen.

I, Valentine Kolb, of the county and State

aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind,

and memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life, and the
certainly of death, do make and declare this my last-Will and
Testament, and do hereby revoke all other Wills heretofore
by me made.

Item 1. - I will and direct that my body be decently
buried.

Item 2. - I will and direct that all my just debts
be paid.

Item 3. - It is my will and desire that all my
property, be kept together, until my youngest child becomes
of age, but that my Executrix hereinafter named may make any
advancements to any of my said children, as a loan, as she may
think proper, not to exceed their proportionate part of my said
estate.

Item 4. - I will and direct that the Guardian of my
children hereinafter named, shall have all of my said children

Item 2. - I will and direct that all my just debts and liabilities be paid, and direct that my body be accounted and disposed of as I shall direct.

Item 3. - It is my will and desire that all my property, be kept together, until my youngest child becomes of age, but that my Executrix hereinafter named may make such advancements to any of my said children, as a loan, as she may think proper, not to exceed their proportionate part of my said estate.

Item 4. - I will and direct that the Guardian of my said children hereinafter named, shall have all of my said children well educated and supported even to any encroachment upon the corpus of said estate.

Item 5. - I will and direct that my said Executrix have full and undivided right and power to dispose of all of my property, either real or personal, by sale, either public or private, as she may see proper, and vest the proceeds of such sales as she may think best - or to use the same in the education and maintenance of my said children.

Item 6. - I hereby appoint my beloved wife, Eliza Hall, my Executrix, to carry out this my last Will and Testament, and I do further appoint my said wife, the Guardian of my children during their minority, with all the powers above specified.

Item 7. - It is my will and desire that at the time when my youngest child becomes of age, all of my said property then remaining, after the education and maintenance of said children, The
