same by will or otherwise
as he may deem proper
I also give & bequeath to my
son Thomas L. in the
manner following utensils belonging
on said land together with my
House hold & kitchen furniture and
young head stock cattle eight
head Hogs together with their
grasses from now until the
time of my death all without
limitation or reserve

And the residue of my property
both real and personal where ever
or what ever in may be at my
death that may not be mentioned
in this my last will
I give bequeath and devise
to my son Thomas L. who
is a minor at this being
only 15 years of age
And I hereby constitute &
appoint appoint any Grand
Jury L. Smith Guardian of the
person and property of my

And I hereby constitute
and appoint my friend
C. J. Meddows Executor of
my last will & Testament
for ever - This November
the 9th day 1891
