I do therefore make this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking
and annulling all others by me
heretofore made

First I desire and direct that my body
be buried in decent and Christian
like manner suitable to my condition
in life. My soul I trust shall
return to both God who gave it

as I hope for salvation through the
merits and atonement of the blessed
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Secondly I desire and direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by
my executors herein after named
and appointed.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Mary Curry for and during
her natural life only the following
described property to wit. Lot of Land
no (414) four hundred and fourteen
and containing (490) four hundred
and ninety acres more or less
and being the same upon which
I now live also Lot of Land no
(421) four hundred and Twenty one
Except one hundred and Twenty five
acres more or less being the whole of
said lot lying North East of
what is known as the Friar
Branch so that the part included

herein contains Three hundred and
sixty five acres more or less being
that portion of said lot lying
South East of said Friar Branch
said lots of Land was four hundred
and fourteen and four hundred
and Twenty one both lying and being
in the original first Division of splitting

household and Kitchen Furniture together
with all Farming and other implements
I may be possessed of also one hundred
head of stock cattle marked with
an under square and under bar in
each ear and branded with the letters
J. C. also Two hundred head of stock
sheep marked with an under square
and under bar in each ear.

I give and bequeath to my daughter
Katharine Merritt five dollars in
United States Currency

Fifthly I give and bequeath to the heirs at
law of my deceased son A. S. Curry
Twenty dollars in United States Currency

Sixth I give and bequeath to the heirs at
law of my deceased daughter Mary J.
Sellers Twenty dollars in United
States Currency

Seventh I give and bequeath to my daughter
Mary Ann Willcox five dollars in
United States Currency

Eighth I give and bequeath to my son
Dan T. Curry one hundred in United
States Currency

Ninth I give and bequeath to my son J. R.
Curry five dollars in United States
Currency

Tenth The residue of my property both
real and personal whatsoever and
whenever it may be at the time of
