

William N. Normant To John Lamkin and Mary
State of Georgia Recorded 8. Dec. 1890

This indenture made the first day
of June one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
four the twenty third year of the American independence be
tween William Charles Normant of the County of ^{Polk} ~~Cherokee~~ State
aforesaid of the one part & John Lamkin of the County
ty and State aforesaid of the other part, witnesses that the
said William N. Normant for and in consideration of
the sum of five hundred dollars to him in hand well and
truly paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these
premises, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has grant
ed bargained sold released conveyed & confirmed and by
these presents doth grant bargain sell release convey and
confirm unto John Lamkin his heirs and assigns all that
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County
ty and State aforesaid containing one hundred and fifty
one ^{more or less} ~~more or less~~ on both sides of the big Kiche Creek be
ing the one half three hundred and originally granted to
George McLean and sold to said Normant by the
Magistrate of Richmond County by virtue of an Execution
& being the North east half of said tract met and Mary
to the middle of said creek or to its junction with Sawmill
Creek that part which includes the hurricane hawks
which is laid down in the plat of the aforesaid
grant to have and to hold the said tract of land
and all and singular the rights members and appurten
ances thereof whatsoever to the said tract of land
lying belonging or in anywise appertaining to the
said tract of land with the remainder ever
down runs, issues and profits thereof and every

and things to the only proper use himself and behoof
of him the said John Lamkin his heirs and assigns forever
in absolute fee simple and the said William C. Normont
the said bargained tract of land and premises unto the
said John Lamkin his heirs and assigns against him the
said William C. Normont his heirs George & assigns be
they shall and will warrant and forever defend by their
