

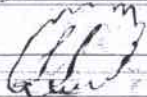
Notley Whitcomb to Allen Warren
Recorded the 15th October 1862
State of Georgia
This Indenture made

the fourth Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and in the twenty fifth year of the Independance of the United States of America Between Notley Whitcomb and Rebekah his wife of the County of Columbia and State aforesaid on the one part and Allen Warren of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Notley Whitcomb and Rebekah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty Dollars to us in hand well and truly paid by the said Allen Warren at or before the sealing hereof delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained granted sold released and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell release and Confirm unto the said Allen Warren his heirs and assigns All that Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred Acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Columbia in the said State on Reeds Creek butting even bounded as follows beginning at a post Oak and running N 39 E forty two Chains and 40 Links to a Lighthouse Knot Corner thence S 81 E forty eight Chains and seventy Links to a Red Oak thence S 60 W 39 West forty two Chains and seventy Links to a Corner pointing on a small Chuckquapine and a small hickory thence a direct line to the being the one half of a tract surveyed in the name of Nathaniel

and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof the Notary
Whitcomb hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day
and date above written. The words "William King" eight & thirty five
