Item fourth I Give and bequeath to my son Augustus
B. Moran a negro man named also a mare & Colt
worth twenty five dollars said negro I want valued
and for his share

I want him to have the
balance to make him Equal with my daughters
Item fifth I Give and bequeath to my daughter Caroline
Austin and my other children and her children which
she may have by her present or any future husband
a negro girl named Charlotte and a horse worth
twenty five dollars which I have given a deed of gift
and left my son Augustus W. Moran Master the said
negro I want valued and the value of said negro &
horse to be taken out of an Equal part with my other
children and for her to have the balance to make
her part equal with my other children

Item sixth I Give and bequeath to my son
at one quarter Conner C. Moran

not subject to the contrary of any law
hereafter that either the above named daughters
may marry. And appoint my son Augustus
R. Moran trustee of the property herein bequeathed
It is my desire that if any of my children
marry that they have apart of their share equal with
my daughter Caroline Benton and for the balance of
my Estate to be kept together until my youngest
child marries or reaches of age.

I constitute and appoint my wife Maria
Moran and my son Augustus R. Moran my Executors
to this my last will and Testament

and State of Georgia being weak in body but of sound
