at Davis each the sum of forty dollars
to be paid them when they marry or become
of age.

Fifth. After the payment of my debts
and the above named legacies I
give and bequeath the balance and
remainder of my estate to my wife
Mary Davis during her natural life at
her death to be equally divided
between my children William H Davis
Green W. Davis Milo I Davis Mary
I Davis Margaret M Davis Francis
W. Davis Richard I Davis and

and in duplicate only of my
Mary or my wife dec or annu
Sincerely I do hereby make and constitute

thru I wish that portion of my estate
conveyed to her by the fifth item of this
my last Will. to be sold and Equally divided
