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In the name of God
Amen I John Williams
of the County and State
aforesaid being in health but of perfect mind
and Memory and knowing that ~~man~~ it is
appointed for man once to die and after
death to Judgment and having thought proper
to dispose of what worldly goods has been the
will of God to bestow on me have thought proper
to make and ordain this my last will and testa-
ment
I desire to receive my property
who gave it and my share
from the same

My daughter Tryphena Moore, Rachel
Moore and Louisa M. Riddick in the manner
herein after pointed out.
3rd I give to my friend Wiley Whitchard one
dollar to let him know that I have not
forgotten him.

4th As to my grand daughter Francis Ann
William I conceive that I have given my
son James M. William a proportionable
part of my estate and therefore only
give her five dollars.

5th I leave in the hands of George Moore
one third part of my estate after pay-
ing off my just debts for the use and
maintenance of my daughter Tryphena
Moore to be administered to her necessities
by him ~~and~~ ^{not} or
her heirs and after her death to be divided
between her children.

6th I give unto my daughter Rachel Moore
one other part of my estate in like
manner.

7th I give unto my daughter Louisa M.
Riddick ~~and~~ the other part of my estate
in like manner.

My estate to be sold for a division or
to be divided in any that my executors
may think most equal and just.
8th I appoint George Moore and
Jethro Riddick my executors to carry
my last will and testament.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 10th of June 1852.

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
