and my family that I should make a disposition of the
property with which a kind providence has blessed me
I therefore make this my last Will and Testament
fully revoking and annulling all others heretofore made
by me

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and christian like manner suited to
my circumstances and constitution My soul I trust
will return to rest with God who gave it through
the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose
religion I have faithfully trust
enjoyed this many years

Crawford County Will Book A (1835-1852)
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Item 2nd I desire and direct that all my just debts
be paid by my Executor hereinafter named
with as little delay as possible as I am unwilling
that my creditors should be delayed of their rights
especially as there is no necessity for delay

Item 3rd I desire and direct that all of my property
that I now possess of or may be possessed
of at the time of my decease be sold by my
Executor (viz) my son negroes namely base
about forty five years of age George about 18 years
of age Betty about 13 years of age Peter about
10 years of age Becky Mary about 8 years of age
Anne about 6 years of age and Sally about
4 years of age and any more that may be from
any of the above named negroes before then and

two hundred dollars over and above and
with my other children as he has lived with me
taken care of me during my widowhood
to each of my other children (viz) Lewis Hammack
Solbot & Hammack Hannah W. Hammack Sarah
Moore wife of Samuels Moore Betty Bryan wife of
John Bryan Jane Sanner widow and relict of
John Sanner deceased Catherine Sanner wife of Mathew
Stow Sanner and Martha Wright widow and relict
of Wm. P. Wright deceased I give and devise an
equal distribution of my Estate to each of them

The distributive share allotted to Sarah Moore I
give and bequeath to her and her children that she has
by her present husband or any future husband she
may enter marry with free from the disposition of
her present or any future husband and I appoint
my son Solbot & Hammack Trustee of her distributive
share

The distributive share allotted to Betty Bryan
I give and bequeath to her and her children that
she has by her present or any future husband with
them she may enter marry free from the disposition
of her present or any future husband and I
appoint my son Solbot & Hammack Trustee of
her distributive share

The distributive shares allotted to each of
my daughters Jane Sanner and Martha W.
I give and bequeath to them and their children
that they have had by their present or
any future husband

of a candidate and support my son John
Hammock my lawful executor to execute
this my last will and testament
