and Kitchen furniture during her nat-
ural life. After the death of my wife
I will the above lot of Land Ninety
acres in said District County & State to my
son Daniel Campbell during his natural
life. To my daughter Mary I will
I leave the sum of Ten dollars -
After the death of my wife it is my
will and wish for the property which
is left undivided to be equally divided
between my two daughters Amy Elizabeth
and Margaret Campbell - After my
decease Mr Frank Redding Blount has one
horse bridle and saddle out of my property
In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal the 19th day of September
in the year of our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and sixty three
