Decatur County 3 I Benjamin F. Rodgers of said State
and County being in a low and Deputy County Clerk Georgia 1828-1838
and knowing life to be uncertain www.gao.gov and that death is
certain sooner or later and that I must depart from
this world when a kind Providence shall so decree
it - Therefore I deem it right and proper as respects
myself and friends that I should make a disposition
of my property which a kind Providence has blessed
me. I therefore make this my last will & testament

Item 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried
in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition - My soul I trust shall
return to rest with God who gave it - 2nd I desire
and direct that the graves of my Father John Rogers
and my Mother Mary Rogers and my Sisters grave
Martha Rogers all and each of them be decently
enclosed with Brick - My Fathers being at the Grave
yard of the Widow Martha McGriff My Mothers grave
at Richard Belmont where also my Sisters is - I also
desire and direct that my body be buried at the
Presbyterian Church near Attapulguas and that my
grave be decently and substantially enclosed with brick

3rd I desire that all my just debts be paid without
delay by my executors hereinafter named as I am
unwilling my creditors should be delayed of their
rights - 4th I give and bequeath to my worthy
and esteemed friend James Griffin one third
of my estate after all my debts and expenses
is paid which portion of my Estate I desire and
direct that it shall be equally divided after his
death or sooner if he may see fit and proper
among his children that he had by his first wife
but no part thereof to go to his last wife or her
children but exclusively to the children of his
first wife

as above specified - &c. I further desire and direct
that all the remainder of my Estate wherever and
whatever it may be I devise and bequeath to be
equally divided between Bradford Rogers and Richd
Hins.

James Griffin Executor to this my last will and
testament this the 11th day of May 1853
