Thanks be to God it! Do make and ordain my last will
and Testament, Viz, First of all I return my soul to Al-
mighty God that gave it and my body to the earth to be used
in a decent and Christianlike manner and as to such
worldly goods as it has pleased God to bless me with I give &
dispose of the same in the manner following Viz.

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Margaret
the whole of my estate both real and personal for her to be
freely enjoyed and possessed during her natural life and
after her death to be divided as follows Viz

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my son Alexander one negro
man named Charles

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved son Archibald all
my lands of which I am possessor also a negro man named
Andrew and a negro woman Isabel (with the exception of
her increase so far as her next two children as well as one
now at her breast hereafter disposed of in Item 4th)

Item 4th To my beloved daughter Watschet one negro by her name

Item 5th To my beloved daughters Nancy Victor & Sarah Patterson
the increase of a negro woman Isabel bequeath to
my son Archibald, so far as to extend to two children
one for each and no further, also my stock of cattle
to be equally divided between my aforesaid Daughters Nancy
and Sarah.

Item 6th I leave my horses, traps, and all my household goods &
furniture at the disposal of my beloved wife aforesaid in
Item 1st to be divided or bequeathed as to her shall seem just & right.

Item 7th I nominate constitute and appoint my son Alexander executor to
this my last will & Testament to pay all my just
debts, receive and collect where debts may be due and
transact any business wherein my estate may be interested
thereby making all former wills heretofore made void & of no effect

that the above named negroes to wit Jack & old Tom Leach & Melinda
Isaac Miller & Melly be equally divided among the legates hereinafter
named in this will (except my dear daughter Mary Ann Blount).

Item second. I also give and bequeath unto my dear wife Catharine one half
of the money that may be collected out of my notes and
accounts for and during the term of her widowhood, and
at the expiration of such term the same shall go to my
son Jacob Blount, but it is my wish that my dear wife
