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Not a tight binding

I Elias Pullin of the County of Decatur State of Georgia
being of sound mind and memory and knowing that of malle-
to station and the laws of God all flesh must die and as the
Lord has blessed me with the goods of this world to him on I have
thought proper to make and ordain this my last will & testament
1st I Commit my body to the earth and my soul to the Lord
that gave it

2nd My will and desire is that after death my body be decently
buried according to the Common Custom

3rd My will is that all my last debts be paid out of any money
that may arise out of the sales of such property as may hereafter
remain or that may come to hands of my Executor who will be hereinafter
named

4th My will and desire is that my beloved wife Rebecca Pullin
have one Negro girl Wannah for her own use and her own use
during her natural life and after her death my beloved wife death
to go to my beloved Children if any I have living if none of my
Children is then living to be Equally divided amongst my people as the
Law would give in such cases with all the income of said Negro
girl Wannah since that my beloved wife have one third part of the
money arising from the sales of any personal property here held
after my death after all my last debts are paid out of the
money arising from the sales of the same.

5th I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary Ann Eliza
abith Pullin and the Child that may be born to her is now
born with if born alive one Negro woman Liza and all her
income to the two said Children to be Equally divided between the
two for their own use to be taken care of by my Executor who will
be hereafter named

6th My will and desire is that my Negro man Sam be set at
liberty to work for himself and to have the control of my Execu-
tor and if he should become an infirm to be supported out of
my Childrens property

2nd my will and desire is that all my personal property and
all my horn hog cattle house hold and kitchen furniture and all
my apert not otherwise named be sold to the best advantage
for the benefit of my heirs and Creditors
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Note: Right binding

8th I do hereby appoint and ordain my friend Henry Coker
my sole Executor to this my last will & testament and
all others for him the said Henry Coker to do as best for
the heirs and Creditors as may seem meet to him & lawful

Pullin sign the same as witnesses in the presence of the Testator
and each other together with themselves
