Item 2^d I desire and direct that all my
just debts be paid without delay in time
of the law by my executors herein after appointed
Item 3rd I give bequest & devise to my beloved
wife Mary with whom I have lived in the
strictest quiet ever since our marriage my
negro woman Slave free from all charges
or limitations whatever to her own hewer
we benefit and labor forever Also I leave
to my beloved wife Mary ten & during her
lifetime or widowhood only all and singular
of my estate real personal and perishable
that I am in possession of at my death then
to be divided between my children as I shall
hereinafter direct and devise

Item 4th I give bequest and devise to my son
William C. One horse and saddle one bed and
bed clothing all of which property I have given
in his possession - Also at my death my negro
boy Ted which he hath not in his power to have
freedom

Item 5th I give bequest & devise to my son Joseph

In my negro girl Della and her increase, also
one bay mare and saddle one bed and bed
clothing all of which property I have given in
his possession to him forever

Nancy Buffin wife of James Buffin one negro
girl named Charlotte and her increase. Also
one black man one bed and bed clothing all
of which property I gave in his possession in
and during her first husband's lifetime to her

Item 7² I give bequeath and devise to my grand
children Augustus M, Mary J, Susan E and
Elizabeth T. Shaw children of my daughter Mary
wife of Elizjiah Shaw both deceased my negro
girl Emily and her increase. Also one small
horse, one bed and bed clothing all of which
property I gave in her possession before her
death to her forever X

Item 8² I give bequeath & devise to my son Lewis
S. my negro girl Maria about sixteen years
of age and her increase also one horse and
saddle one bed and bed clothing all of which
property I have given in his possession to him forever

Item 9² I give bequeath and devise to my son James
S. my negro girl named Hannah and her
increase at the death of myself and my wife
Mary also one horse and saddle bed & bed
clothing all of which property except the girl
Hannah I have given in his possession to him forever

Item 10² I give bequeath and devise to my daughter
Elizabeth Mock wife of John Mock my negro
boy named Elick - also the money to buy a saddle
bed & bed clothing all of which property I have
given in his possession to her forever

Item 11² I give bequeath and devise to my daughter

Pack Douglass wife of John C. Douglass one
horse, bed and bed covering Decatur County Georgia wills
city I have given in her possession also my
negro girl named Nancy and her moneys at
mine and my wifes death to her forever.

Item 12^o I give bequest and devise to my daughter
Martha my negro boy named George at mine
and my wife Mary death also one bed and
bed clothing and two hundred dollars in
money out of my estate when called for to
her forever.

Item 13^o I give bequest and devise to my son
Hezekiah & one small horse and saddle which
I have given in his possession also my negro boy
named Ben - bed and bed clothing at the
death of myself and wife Mary to him forever.

Item 14^o I give bequest and devise to my son Abram
B one big horse and saddle which I have given
in his possession - Also my negro boy named
Bob bed and bed clothing at the death of
myself and wife Mary to him forever.

Item 15^o I will desire and direct that the rem-
ainder and residue of my estate not herein
described shall be sold at the death of myself
and my wife Mary in terms of the last
and equally divided between all my children
with the exception of my daughter Nancy
Giffen and I desire and direct that her per-
petual part arising from said remainder
of my estate as mentioned above shall go to
my grand son William A. Smith son of Nancy
Giffen as he is prudentially afflicted and
is not able to make a support - with the exception
of eighty dollars of said proportionable part de-
sired for William A. Smith which eighty dollars
I desire and direct to be divided equally
