my just debts if any 2nd I give and bequeath to my

and Conrod Harrell. Josiah Harrell and my Daughter Willy
each with the sum of Eighty Dollars each in cash or cattle
as they choose the said sum to belong to their Children
after my Death. 3rd I bequeath and give to my son
John Harrell the sum of Eighty Dollars in cash or cattle
as he chooses. 4th I give and bequeath to my son
William W. Harrell the sum of one Thousand Dollars in
cash or cattle as he may choose. 5th I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Maryann Rachel Harrell the sum
of one hundred and Fifty Dollars in cash or cattle as she
may choose. 6th I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife
Anna the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in cash or
cattle as she may ^{choose} ~~select~~ which is to be her property
during her lifetime or widowhood then to belong to
William W. Harrell as his property and then at the death
of the said William W. Harrell his whole Estate to go to
his heirs. I also desire that all the balance of my
perishable ^{Estate} ~~property~~ household and kitchen furniture
to be sold on a credit of 6 months immediately after
my death: and I also desire that my heirs should
equally divide the proceeds of said said among them
selves. I do appoint and ordain my two sons
Josiah and Camas Harrell my lawful Executors
I put special confidence in the judgement and
integrity of my Executors I desire that they dispense
with making returns as required by law I give
my Executors power to manage for the minor
