Gretna County I John Jones of the above State & County being at the
time very ill by reason of affliction of body but of sound mind & memory
and calling to mind that it is appointed unto man once to die
and after death the judgment. Therefore I have thought fit & proper
to make this my last will & Testament as follows,

First I recommend my Soul to Almighty God who gave it me &
my body to the discretion of my Executor,
Secondly it is my will that all of my debts be paid out of my estate
that its has pleased God to bless me with. Thirdly, it is my
will to leave in the possession of my beloved wife (Phoebe Jones for her
support & the support of my minor children) during her natural life
or widowhood the following property (viz: all my house hold & kitchen
furniture with the present crop together with all the plantation
tools and one Two horse wagon; also ~~one~~ ^{one} horse named Char-
ley, also my Stock of Cattle & hogs, It is my will also that my son
J. M. Jones have one bay mare named Fanny, I give also to my
son Almon Jones one spotted colt named George Story, I give also
to my son James J. Jones one sorrel colt named Frank. I give
also to my son Floyd J. Jones one bay Colt named John B. B. B.
I give also to my son George W. Jones one sorrel mare named
Nelly. It is my will also that my daughter Louisa Jones have
two cows and calves & one feathered & furniture to be ~~fitting~~ ^{fitting} for her
when she comes of age or marries. It is my will also that one
sorrel mare named Rose be sold for the purpose of schooling
my horse named Rose. I give also to my son John

and N. N. Jones have the sum of five dollars out of my Estate as his entire share. It is my will also that my son John Jones have the sum of five dollars out of my Estate as his entire share.

It is my will also that my daughter Milly Jones have the sum of five dollars out of my Estate as her entire share.

It is my will also that my son-in-law Joshua I. Van have the sum of five dollars out of my Estate as his entire share.

It is my will also in case of the death or marriage of my wife Phoeby Jones that all the balance of my Estate be equally divided amongst my six youngest children (viz, P. J. Jones, Almon Jones, James Jones, Royd J. Jones, Louisa Jones & George W. Jones).

It is my will also that my two grand-children (viz, Gerobabel Jones & John Jones) have three cows and calves and to be under the control of my Executor.

It is my will also that should my wife Phoeby Jones marry that she have one feather bed and furniture as her entire share of my Estate.

And I hereby appoint ordain & constitute my trusty son J. J. Jones my Executor to this my last will and Testament, done the day & date first above written.
