Secondly. I do give and bequeath unto my wife Frances M. Crocker

whereon I now live together with all my stock
Household and Kitchen furniture and plantation
tools (except such as I may dispose of otherwise)
together with the whatever I have or have I may own at
my death. It is my will and desire that my said wife and
son as aforesaid do live together and enjoy my plantation
and property as above stated in common during the
life or widowhood of my said wife Frances
but should my said wife turn fool and marry then
and in that case she is to have none of my property
than what the law of Georgia will allow her and
the remainder of the property aforesaid to belong
to my son John Robert Lewis M. Crocker absolutely
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my three daughters namely
Ellen B. Price Ephzibah Price and Charlotte C. Miller
each Two Large Silver Table spoons
Fourthly I give unto my grand Daughter Ellenor Charlotte
Frances Price half a dozen Silver Tea spoons
Fifthly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said
wife Frances M. Crocker and my son John Robert
Lewis M. Crocker my Executors of this my last will and
testament and I do hereby declare this and no other to be
my last will and Testament. Witness my hand and seal
this the 22nd Day of March 1833
