they would share by their respective fathers or  
mothers & also my wife Elizabeth. and as I have  
advanced some of my children more than  
the rest I desire here to state the amount principal  
& interest that I have advanced to each so that  
an equal division may be had among my  
children wife & grand children as aforesaid.

First to my daughter Gillah Dempsey my Daughter  
I have herto given Principal & interest the  
sum of two hundred & seventy four  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars  
for which sum I have her notes which are now  
destroyed. Secondly to Polly Carnest I have herto  
given Principal & interest the sum of four  
hundred & seventy six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars for which sum  
I have her notes which are now destroyed.

Thirdly to John Truluck my grand son only  
son of Wm. Truluck I have given the sum of  
four hundred and fifty  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars for which  
Principal & interest I now have his notes which  
are now destroyed. Fourthly to my Daughter  
Mary Newborn I have given the sum of  
one hundred and twenty  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars Principal &

Seventy to my Daughter Louisa Brown I have given the sum of four hundred & twelve Dollars for which I have her notes & which are now destroyed. Eighty to my son Andrew Truluck I have given the sum of one thousand two hundred & fifty four \$100 Dollars Principal & interest for which sum I have his notes & which is now destroyed given up. Ninety to my Daughter Penny Mill I have given the sum of nine hundred and eleven \$100 Dollars for which sum I now hold her notes Principal & interest & which is now given up & destroyed. Tenthly to my son Josiah Truluck I have given the sum of one thousand one hundred & ninety eight \$100 Dollars Principal & interest for which sum I now hold his notes & which is now given up & destroyed. Eleventhly to my son Uriah Truluck I have given the sum of five hundred & ten Dollars Principal & interest for which sum I now hold his notes & which are now given up & destroyed.
