among all of my children & grand children the
same grand children to take the share or part that
would share by their respective fathers or
mothers & also my wife Elizabeth. and as I have
advanced some of my children more than
the rest. I desire here to state the amounts principal
& interest that I have advanced to each so that
an equal division may be had among my
children wife & grand children as aforesaid.

First to my son Gilloch Dempsey my Daughter
I have heretofore given Principal & interest the
sum of two hundred & seventy four ¹/₁₀₀ Dollars
for which sum I have her notes which are now
destroyed. Secondly to Polly Earnest I have heretofore
given Principal & interest the sum of four
hundred & seventy six ³/₁₀₀ Dollars for which sum
I have her notes which are now destroyed.

Thirdly to John Truluck my grand son only
son of Wm. Truluck I have given the sum of
four hundred and fifty ³/₁₀₀ Dollars for which
Principal & interest I now have his notes which
are now destroyed. Fourthly to my Daughter
Nancy Winbourn I have given the sum of
seven hundred and twenty six ⁶/₁₀₀ Dollars Principal &
interest I now have her notes which are now
destroyed. Fifthly to my son Luther Truluck

Eighty and $\frac{2}{100}$ Dollars Principal & interest for which
I now have his notes & which are now de-
stroyed. Sixtly to Sarah Huggins my Daughter
I have given the sum of five hundred & sixty three $\frac{1}{100}$
 $\frac{2}{100}$ Dollars for which sum I now hold her
notes & which are now destroyed. Sevently to

Daughter Louisa Brown I have given the sum
of four hundred & twelve Dollars for which I have
her notes & which are now destroyed. Eightly to
my son Andrew Truluck I have given the sum
of one thousand two hundred & fifty four $\frac{3}{100}$ Dollars
Principal & interest for which sum I have his notes &
which is now destroyed given up. Ninthly to
my Daughter Penny Willy I have given the sum
of nine hundred and eleven $\frac{3}{100}$ Dollars for which
sum I now hold her notes Principal & interest
& which is now given up & destroyed. Tenthly to
to my son Josiah Truluck I have given the
sum of one thousand one hundred & ninety eight $\frac{1}{100}$
Dollars Principal & interest for which sum I now hold
her notes & which is now destroyed. Eleventhly
to my son Ureah Truluck I have given the
sum of five hundred & ten Dollars Principal &
interest for which sum I now hold his notes
which are now given up & destroyed.

Twelvethly to my son James R. Truluck
I have given the sum of one thousand two
hundred and thirty $\frac{1}{100}$ Dollars Principal & interest
for which sum I now have his notes which
are now given up.

shall sell all of my property both real & personal
soon as they conveniently can and after the same
is reduced to money to pay it to the other of
my sons & my wife a sum sufficient so as to
