Harrell Six Negroes May a woman about
Twenty five years old and her children
Dennis a boy & Augustus a boy & Isaac a boy
& Betsy a woman about Twenty one years
of age & Ties a boy about Twenty years of
age. The negroes with increase to her
& the heirs of her body forever for their
sole use & benefit free from the control
debts & encumbrances of her husband.
(Item 2d) I give bequeath & devise to my son
John Brock One hundred acres of land
of Lot No 60 in the Sixteenth District

do 61 in the Sixteenth Dist both tracts in
DeCATUR County also two negro woman
Alta a woman about 18 years of age and
The Man horse fifteen years old and her
Colt about two years old name Polick -
all for his ^{own} use & benefit & their increase.

(Item 3^d) I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary
Bell four negroes, Bincy about thirty two
years old and Antinet about twenty six
years old both women. & Fillee about two
years old a girl & Martha Jane two years
old & eight Hundred dollars ~~their~~ increase
and to her & the heirs of her body forever
for their sole use & benefit free from the
Control debts & incumbrances of her husband.

(Item 4th) I give & bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth Hancell negro woman named
Anancy about thirty four years old and
Child a boy about sixteen years old One Negro
girl Caroline about fourteen years old
Henry a boy twelve years old Charles a boy
ten years old. Said negroes with increase
to her & the heirs of her body forever for
their sole use & benefit free from the control
debts & incumbrances of her husband.

(Item 5th) I give & bequeath to my daughter Anancy
Fricord. Jack a man about thirty four
years old & a negro woman Sally about
fifty five years old & Lucinda a woman
twenty four years old & Salivann about
eight years old & Louisa about five years
old & Francis Marion a boy one year old
Said negroes with increase to her & the
heirs of her body forever for their sole
use & benefit free from the control debts
& incumbrances of her husband.

(Item 6th) I give Bequeath to my Grand children
Jane Parker and Leticia Parker the sum
of Three Thousand Dollars to be raised
by my effects - and in case one of the
children should die the whole to go to
the other - the said money to go to children
& the heirs of their body

(Item 7th) The residue of my property I appoint
to be sold by my executor in Twelve
months time and the proceeds of that
sale to be collected & after paying Three
thousand Dollars to be paid to the
Guardian of Jane Parker & Leticia Parker
the balance to be equally divided with
the exception Elizabeth Hanell the heirs
of my body -

(Item 8th) I do hereby constitute & appoint
my son John Brock Executor of this
my last Will & Testament her
Mark
