State of Georgia, do make declaration
and publish this to be my last will and
Testament.

First - I give, my soul, to God, and desire, that
my body shall be buried, in a manner suit-
able to my condition, in life.

Secondly - It is my will, & desire, and I do hereby
so direct that all my Estate both real and personal
consisting of the following property to wit,
Lots of Land, Nos three hundred, & forty five, (345)
three hundred and sixty six (366) two hundred and
thirty (203) two hundred, and four (204) One hundred
and ninety seven, (197) and two hundred and thirty
seven (237) the first named two situate lying &
being in the fourteenth (14) District of originally Early
now DeKalb County in said State and the last named
four lots of said situation, and being in the twentieth
(20) District in the County and State as aforesaid, con-
taining each two hundred and fifty (250) acres more
or less all of which said Lots of Land, now held by
Johnathon Donaldson, of said County under and on
beas of Trust to my use, and the following negroes
Richard, Claisses, Caroline, Eliza, Elias named
in Decd of Trust from C. R. Young to the said
Johnathon Donaldson, to my use, and Grace
Louise and Dinah the Daughters of Louise, and
Isabella, Juliana, Ellen and George, the minors of
said Eliza and Elijah Angelina, Rachel Louis
Lary Dick, Scipio and Randal the minors of the
minors of the said Eliza, Frances Edmunda, & Perkins
the minors of the said Claisses, also Betty & her
then children Ada Rosetta & Mild, Priscilla, &
her child Florence, Anna and Robin named,

Managers settlement between myself & ones Coamers
Mr. Amos acquiesces out of this property arising
out of this negro first above named, as also
Mary Peter, Billy & Elbur held by the said Johnathon
Donaldson, by deed or deeds of trust to my use
go to and be held by the said Johnathon Don-
aldson in trust and for the use of my Daughter
Malvina C. D. Potter wife of John W. Potter of the County
and State of Louisiana & her heirs forever.

Thirdly It is my will and desire & I do hereby so direct
that the rents and profits issues and income of the
property aforesaid together with all my goods
& chattels moneys notes or other evidences of debt
& choses in action, whether in hand in trust for
me or otherwise be held in trust and for the
use of my Daughter as aforesaid - All of the
above property both real & personal being the pro-
ceeds of the property mentioned in said Deed
of Trust from C. R. Young to Johnathon Donaldson.

Fourthly It is my will & desire and I do so direct that
the said Johnathon Donaldson or any other Trustee
that may be appointed in his stead whomsoever so
directed in writing by ~~my~~ said Daughter shall
dispose of the property or the issues thereof or any
part thereof in manner as my said Daughter
may direct.

Fifthly - It is my will and desire and I do so direct
that my said Daughter shall have the power
from time to time by writing under her
hand and seal to nominate and appoint any other
trustee or trustees in place of the Trustee herein
named, and the same at her pleasure to revoke.

Sixthly - It is my will and desire and I do so direct
that the property herein ~~mentioned~~^{before} mentioned
and the issues thereof shall not be subject to

Seventhy - It is my will and desire and I do so direct that my said Daughter have full power to dispose of the said property & the income thereof by will, as she may see fit.

Easty - I do hereby nominate and appoint the said Jonathan Donaldson the Executor of this my last Will and Testament
