 Decatur County I Nancy M Thomas of the State
 and County aforesaid being
 in full health of body but of sound & improving
 mind & memory (Praised be God for the same)
 and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs
 whilst I have strength & capacity so to do and
 being also authorized and empowered by a decree
 of the Honorable the Court of Equity for the
 District of Edgefield South Carolina made on
 the seventh day of January in the year one
 thousand eight hundred and fifty eight
 in the case of William A S Thomas and
others vs Benjamin Thomas and Wife and others
 to dispose by my instrument of writing sub-
 scribed by me with the formalities prescribed
 by law in respect to last Will & Testaments
 of the property referred to by said decree
 I do hereby in execution of said power and
 subject to the conditions specified in said
 decree make and publish this my last Will
 and Testament hereby revoking and making
 void all former wills by me at any time her-
 tofore made.

And first I commit my soul to the hands of
 my creator who gave it my body to the earth
 to be entombed at the discretion of my Executors
 who are hereby requested to erect over my
 grave a marble slab with a suitable inscrip-
 tion thereon. After payment of my just debts
 & charges I dispose of my estate as follows
 I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter
 Laura G. Blight the wife of H. H. Blight my slave
 Eliza together with her issue in common as well
 those born before as those born after my death
 for sole and separate use benefit and behoof

and not to be liable to the debts, contracts
or engagements of present or any future hus-
band for and during the term of her natu-
ral life and at her death it is my will
that said slave and her issue and increase
as aforesaid shall become the property of
the children of my said daughter who
may survive her share and share alike
provided that if any of my said Grand
Children (the Children of my said daugh-
ter) shall have died during the life
time of their mother leaving issue the
issue of such deceased grand child shall
represent the deceased parent and take
the share which said parent if then
living would have been entitled to receive
I give and bequeath my gold watch and
chain my gold spectacles breast-pin finger
rings and silver spoons to my said daughter
Laura T. Bliett for her sole and separate
use during her life and upon her death
I give the same to my grand daughter
Berma L. Bliett but this bequest is made
on the condition upon the death of my said
daughter my grand son Almarie B. Bliett
shall have his mother's watch. I give and
bequeath to my said daughter Laura T.
Bliett all my clothes. I direct that all
my beds bedding and bed clothing and all
my household and Kitchen Furniture be di-
vided equally between my said daughter Lau-
ra T. Bliett and my son Dr G. A. Green
I give and bequeath to my son Dr G. A. Green
my slave Fiolet solely and absolutely
I give and bequeath my lot of land in the
town of Aiken S. C. adjoining lots of W. H. Green

Moving the Trust Estate of Randol with all the improvements on said lot to my daughter Laura F. Eliott and my son Dr C. A. Green to be sold privately or publicly as my Executors think best the proceeds of which to be equally divided between my said daughter & son the share of my daughter to include the same as the slave Eliza.

I give and bequeath to my grand daughters Ida Green & Florence Augusta Green children of my deceased son Augustus A. Green two thousand dollars to be held in trust by my Executors until said grand children become of age provided my Executors don't see they needed it in some way before, then in that case they may use so much of the interest as they may think best for their benefit. in case one of the children dies without issue it is my will that the remaining sister have it but in case both die without issue, it is my will that the children of Glover F. Green have it to be equally divided between them.

I give and bequeath the remaining notes money accounts and every thing I may be seized & possessed of to my daughter L. F. Eliott & my son Dr C. A. Green to be equally divided between them.

Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Dr C. A. Green & my son in law G. H. Eliott the Executors of my last Will & Testament to execute & carry into effect this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have to this my will set my hand and seal this the twenty first day of May A.D. 1861 thousand eight hundred and sixty one
