 declare this my last Will and Testament
 in the manner and form following

Item 1st I give and bequeath my Soul to God
 who gave it

Item 2^d I desire my body to be interred in the
 Church laid by my Husband

Item 3^d I desire that all my just debts be
 paid out of my Estate

Item 4^d I give and bequeath all my household &
 kitchen furniture including Beds Bed-
 clothes all my wearing clothing &c to my
 three Daughters to wit Mary Griffin Rebecca
 Smicord & Elizabeth Cassiter their heirs
 to be equally divided between them as
 they may desire as soon as I depart this life

Item 5th I give and bequeath my servant girl Celia
 aged 13 years to my son George W. Donahem
 his heirs for him to have & to hold as his own
 for his use forever

Item 6th I desire that my boy Richmond, George
 servants also my Mare Buggy some horse
 Wagon also one stand of Lightning Rods now
 owned by belonging to the same also the contents
 of my smoke-house consisting of Bacon Lard
 & two bushels & a half of salt y^t at my son
 William S. Donahem all be sold the proceeds
 of which (together with the money notes
 and one account against my son William
 for the hire of the boy Henry for the past year
 1863) amounting to a balance of one hundred
 and fifty two dollars) I give and bequeath

to my three daughters & my grand children
the heirs of my daughter Nancy and Martha
to be equally divided among them that
is Nancy children one part & Martha's
one part & Mary Griffin one part Rebecca
Friend one part & Elizabeth Lescotte one
part

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my daughter
Jane Wilkin the sum of two hundred
dollars for her portion of my estate which
will be paid out of the proceeds of
sales of the last Item to wit the 6th

Item 8th I desire that my carpenter tools also
farming tools & scumblers & so also my cattle
& hogs be equally divided among my
three sons George, William, & Stephen

I also request that my son George have
the privilege of cultivating my little farm
as I have been at the expense of repairing
the fencing &c

I desire & I do hereby constitute and appoint
my son George H. Smalson & my son in law
John Griffin my executors to this my last
will & testament which I desire them to
execute immediately after my departure
as I would if I were living & desired to do
so without the expense of a regular process
of law
