

In the name of God Amen - Considering the
uncertainty of life, especially of a volunteer
& in the service of my country the glorious
South, I Robert Givens Staller of Deaton
County State of Georgia formerly of South
Carolina - being of sound mind & memory
free from the influence of liquor or injustice
do ordain & declare this to be my (first &) last
Will & Testament - That is to say - First I
desire my executors (or attorney) to pay my
last account medical bills overseer wages
other debts that will not require the sale
of any of my real or personal estate & to offer
a gift of (\$300⁰⁰) four hundred dollars to any
one who will bring my body (if dead) to Quincy
Florida which shall be placed by the side
of my father & my brother & facts shall erect
a suitable monument to cost not less than
five hundred dollars place around it an
iron railing - Secondly I desire my facts
to pay with the proceeds arising from the
sale of the crop to be made on the farm at
Towleton Georgia all the notes held by the
Admrs of Est William Williams signed by Rich.
Givens Staller to whom the farm equally belongs
but after all the debts of the farm shall have
been settled to demand & obtain an equal division
of the entire farm to both real & personal - Thirdly
if the proceeds of the crop are not sufficient
to meet obligations I give the facts full power
to buy mules or sell old ones if necessary & to
hire men negroes if deemed necessary by them
to buy provisions sell crop both animal vegetable
to the interest of the estate, to hire overseer
& other workers that may be deemed by them
necessary monthly - After an equal division

shall have been effected by sale or apprenticeship
to purchase a farm & such stock as may be
necessary to carry on a farm etc, hence all of
my negroes or those that fall to me, on said
farm, to his or their if necessary to pay
for said farm & stock with the proceeds
of the crops after said farm shall have
been paid for or the amount of purchase
money made - to continue the farm seven
years. Fifthly to apply the proceeds of
the crops after the incidental & current
expenses out of obligations which they
may make for interest of farm shall be
paid as follows - to give to my mother &
sister if they or either be alive each the
sum of three hundred dollars yearly to be
paid alone to them & to loan the remainder
if there be any to use of my present brother
who shall be chosen by placing a strip of
paper for each one in a hat or one of each
paper shall be written "money" after shaking
the hat raising it above, to draw fairly one
of the strips the one drawing the paper man
his "Money" shall be entitled to the use
of the money but shall be required to give
good security ofay legal interest; to deposit
of the crops of following year in the same
manner leaving out each time the name or
names of those drawing the former prizes
If my brother should not want the use of
the money then my trustees are desired requested
to loan the money to some responsible person
with two good prompt securities concerning the
notes, every two years or until the several years
shall have expired - securing each year suffi-
cient money to buy miles, provisions, land &c

living of negroes & other things that may be deemed necessary by them - Sixthly I desire my executors to move or cause to be moved my negroes & other property from the State of Alabama & to place them on the farm with other negroes whether it be in Florida Georgia or any State of the present Southern Confederacy - to sell my interest in other lands lying in Florida & elsewhere which they may deem necessary to the interest of my farm and when all debts shall have been paid & seven years expired or seven crops be made to sell my entire estate both real personal & every thing belonging to me in my estate & after giving the sum of five thousand dollars to the first legitimate son of one of my present brothers who shall bear the name of Robert Anselius Waller - if said nephew be not born - then the amount of five thousand dollars be applied to the education of a son in law for the Baptist Ministry every year till said sum ~~shall~~ ^{shall} have spent it having been placed in the care of Waller Trustee by my executors - And then & finally to divide the remainder if there be any equally between my sister & brothers provided my mother be supported by them till death - Should any of brothers or my sister be dead then the amount be divided equally among the living ones of my mothers family - Should a nephew bear the name of Robert Anselius Waller not live to the age of twenty one then the amount given to him is to be given to next nephew who shall bear same name - I also will my male heirs to my nephews Albert & Kilianus my gold watch to my brother James L. Waller - My love now to my brother Codorus Waller my violin to my youngest

brother Edw and R. Stalter - I will that my surviving horse & carriage be sold & the money to be used for the purchase of a fine gold watch & chain to be presented to my niece Jessie Kilcrease when she shall attain the age of fifteen - I likewise will to each of my brothers who shall not be my executors the additional sum of three hundred dollars yearly besides the legal per cent And I further will that should any of my brothers attempt to break or set aside this my last will that said brother or brothers be deprived of his or their portion of my estate - his or their portion being distributed equally to the others

And I hereby nominate and appoint my brothers Godens & Stalter & Delius Stalter in case of their deaths of either of them the remainder of my brothers tho in more than two shall act at me to be executors of this my last will and Testament - There in four interlineations appear to complete sense none containing more than 4 words

In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name & affixed my seal this the twenty sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & sixty one (1861)
