I Black Garrison Sr. of the County of Ocrake & State of Georgia being of Sound Mind & Memory & knowing that it shall be to the Honor and the will of God all flesh shall die. and as the Lord has blessed me with a portion of this world's Goods to live on: I have thought proper to make and Ordain this my last will and Testament Revoking all others

1st I Comend my soul to God that gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian like manner by my surviving friends

2nd My will and desir is that all my just debts be paid out of any money money that I may have at the time of my death if any I have if none out of the sale of such property as my executors may raise out of such property sold for that purpose —

3rd My will & desir is that my beloved wife Ann Garrison have my plantation when I am here including all lot No 210 in the sixteenth district of formerly Early now Ocrake County and also my Claim on No 251 in the same County and district with the Crop of Corn also the crop of growing Corn at my demise with the farming tools & household furniture bedding and furniture & breadstuffs, kitchen furniture or as much of the above as she wants to keep for her use together with my stock of Hogs and Cattle with ten horses of her choice out of my stock of horses with the following negroes Viz Arnold a man Easter a woman Corbet a woman Adam a boy Will a boy Ebany a girl Polly a girl all to belong to her during her life time — Then to be sold by my Executors who I shall herein after name for the purpose of distribution among those I shall hereafter name

4th I give and bequeath to Martha Garrison Widow of Archibald Garrison One dollar & fifty Cents in money —

5th I give and bequeath to Seaton Hall that married my beloved Daughter Ann Garrison one dollar & fifty Cents in cash money

6th I give & bequeath to Isaac P. Smith that married my beloved Daughter Polly Ann Garrison the sum of one dollar & fifty Cents in money —

7th I give and bequeath to Rebecca Garrison Widow Charles Garrison & deceased the sum of One dollar and fifty Cents in money —

8th I give & bequeath to Margaret Garrison the Daughter of Rebecca Garrison Widow of Charles Garrison One dollar & fifty Cents in money —

of the property of the life Estate of my wife. —

9th My will & desire is that all my estate both real & personal not otherwise named be disposed of at sale on twelve months credit or on the most advantageous terms to the estate both heirs & creditors to be divided as follows after deducting the legitt and expenses

10th That that my beloved daughter Elly Smatts have and receive one third part of the proceeds of the sale of all the property that is sold at my death and that at the death of my wife my Executors sell all that belong to the life Estate of my wife and after paying the legitt & expenses Elly Smatts have the share of that also

11th I give and bequeath to the Children of M^r London Gairy by Martha Gairy his wife & the Children of Elizabeth Brooks that she have by Isaac J Brooks each and all of them to have an equal share & share alike of the other two thirds proceeds of the sale of the property that is to be sold of the Estate of the other two thirds after the legitt & expenses is paid

12th My will and desire is that my Executors keep the money out at interest for the Children of Martha Gairy by M^r London Gairy and the Children of Elizabeth Brooks by Isaac J Brooks till the said heirs come at the age of fourteen years & age & choose their Guardian

13 I do make Ordain & appoint John Hays of Baker County William Chilton Jr of Palmale County & Henry Arlind of Dretter County all of the State of Georgia My Executors to carry the true intent of this my last will & testament into execution after my death & to act as they shall deem best for the intent of the heirs & creditors

Preston County I Mary Hamble of the above named
place being well in body & of sound mind & memory do make this my last will & testament in manner follow-
-ing: First of all I commend my soul to almighty God who gave
it & bid my body to be decently interred and after my funeral expenses
and all my just debts are paid. I give and bequeath to my three grand
Children Abnera Clementa & Saml Hamble one fourth part each
which I wish to be retained in the hands of my Daughter Mary until
they are truly one hand of age or marriage.

Item Second I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Hamble my
negroes namely Will & Rose -

Item Third I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Hamble
one negro girl named Rhina and five hundred dollars in money
to her and the heirs of her body one fourth with all the income of the said
negro girl Rhina

Item Fourth it is my will that all the balance of my Estate both
Real and personal (after paying all my just debts and giving my daugh-
-ter Mary five hundred dollars as above mentioned) be equally divided
between my son Samuel and Daughter Mary. And it is my desire that
that they make such division themselves.
