

In the name of God - Amen - The 18th day of November One thousand eight hundred and sixty two - I Reuben Cloud of the County of Gwinnett State of Georgia Gentlemen being now through the blessing of God in a sound state of body and mind and memory but calling to mind the frailty of life - that it is appointed to all men once to die - do make and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally and first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me and the disposal of my body I leave to the entire discretion of my friends - With respect to my worldly estate I give bequests and dispose of it in the manner and proportions here following.

First I give and bequeath to my dear son Peter M Cloud two negro slaves as follows Sam a man about twenty years old and Lydia a woman about fifty five years old as his full and entire portion of my estate to be delivered to him within one month after my decease.

Also I give to my dear sons each Martin L. Cloud and Reuben Cloud Jr and Aaron DeKathy Cloud and William Jasper Cloud and Isa Moton Cloud each one the sum of One thousand dollars and one hundred valued at one hundred and fifty dollars to be paid to them as they attain the age of twenty one years or enter into matrimony.

Also I give and bequeath to my dear daughter Barbara A. Cloud whom I make my sole executrix of this my last will and testament the sum of One thousand dollars and one hundred and fifty dollars to be paid when she becomes twenty one years of age or enters into the State of Matrimony.

And also all and singular my lands and tenements per-

messager and funded property with the exception above
named to be equally divided between Martin L. Cloud
Barbra A. Cloud Reuben Cloud & Aaron DeKalt
Cloud William Jasper Cloud and Isa Newton Cloud
when Isa Newton Cloud my youngest son shall
attain the age of twenty one years or enter into matrimony

Also I give my executors power and authority to
settle all demands for and against my estate out of
any funds that may be found in my possession
at my decease not before excepted.

And finally it is my will that if my dear
daughter Barbra A. Cloud should depart this
life without an heir that her portion of my estate
be divided equally between her brothers to be divided
between her issue if any and I do hereby utterly
disallow revoke and disannul all and every other
former testament with signatures bequeaths and executors
by me in any way before named reviled and disannuled
ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my
last will and testament.
