after named & appointed

Thirdly I give bequeath & devise to my beloved
wife Sarah all my real & Personal Estate
consisting as follows viz Lot of Land No 257
Two hundred & fifty seven 150 One hundred
& fifty Acres of lot No 258 Two Hundred & fifty
eight all lying in the Nineteenth District of
DeCATUR County Georgia Also my Servants Horist
a Woman about forty years of age Moses a
Man about Twenty three years of age James a man
about Twenty one years of age Also my Stock
consisting of Hogs Horses Cattle & Sheep together
with all my household & Kitchen Furniture
And I hereby give to my wife Sarah full
power & authority to manage the above named
estate in any way that may seem to her best
for the benefit of herself & family during her
life viz to sell or dispose of in any way she
may deem proper And at the death of my
wife Sarah it is my wish that what remains of
the Estate be equally divided among my
heirs And I hereby nominate constitute
& appoint my said trustees Peter Vandringham
& Stephen M. Chester executors of this my last
will & Testament Samuel Cooper (23)
